# Opening Winter 2011–12

A wind-resistant, fixed-grip quad chairlift will open in the heart of our beloved steeps. Best of all, approximately 135 acres of new terrain will open giving skiers access to Burnt Mountain.

Phase 3 of the terrain expansion opens the north face of Burnt Mountain with the addition of approximately 250 acres.
